

**A TERRIER OF THE GLEBELANDS BELONGING TO THE RECTORY OF
RINMORE IN WOODLEIGH DEANERY & DIOCESE OF EXETER, MADE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD 1749. BY THE COMMAND AND
DIRECTION OF THE RT. REVD. FATHER IN GOD, NICHOLAS LORD
BISHOP OF EXETER.**

The Parsonage house is built wth. Stone, & cover'd wth slate. It contains three cellars, the floors are earth. The passage, Hall, Kitchen and dairy are laid wth stone... Above stairs are eight rooms floor'd with board, all plastered wth lime, none wainscoted...The outhouses are a Barn of feet long, a straw house, a stable feet long, a smal oxtal, all built with stone and thatcht. The Glebe, wch consists of three tenements, & a parcel of land called Sevenstones is in the whole about eighty four acres....all inclos'd with hedges, fo the most part belonging to it...The Home tenement contains the courledge, gardens and houses about one acre & $\frac{1}{4}$...three little meadows six acres and seventy six perch..nine inclosures of arable land wch lye contiguous & are bounded on the east by the highway. On the south & part of the west by the lands of Mr.Kirkham ; other part by the Barton of Ockenbury...On the north by lands of Mr.Shepherd ; to the same tenement belong the church meadow $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre bounded by the west and south by the highway, on the east by lands of Mr.Kirkham ; - as also Heals two acres and $\frac{1}{4}$ bounded on the south by the highway on the east by lands of Dotten; on the north by lands of Mr Shepherd. on the west by lands of Mr.Kirkham...Marwell tenement contains a barn and straw house, a garden and field behind it, the whole about three acres ; it fences itself a meadow about one acre ; a wet plot adjoining about twenty six perch. a plot wthin it now an orchard of about sixty perch, bounded on the northe east by the lands of Mr.Kirkham. On the South of Mr.Shepherd, wthin these is a small plot belonging to a tenement att Marwell (now in the possession of Peter Lambell)The occupier of wch tenement has a way thro these two plots, part of the glebe to his said plot; and the Rector of Rinmore and his Tenants have a way thro' the said tenement to Marwell village. Two field about nine acres and a $\frac{1}{4}$ called Marwell downs, bounded on the East and South by the highway, on the North by lands of Mr.Kirkham, on the West by part of Renton tenement.....another field about nine acres and a $\frac{1}{4}$ called the Barton, bounded on the North by the same highway. On the East and South and part of the West by lands of Mr.Kirkham. on another part of the West by the Barton of Ockenbury.

It looks as if the document finishes here but there is a hint of further writing and it is at least unlikely that there was no signature to the document.....search at Devon C.R.O. ?

A Terrier of the Glebelands &c. belonging to the Rectory of Rinmore, in Wodeleigh Deanery, & Diocese of Exeter, made in the year of our Lord 1745. By the command & direction of the R. Revd. Father in God, Nicholas Lord Bishop of Exeter.

The Parsonage House is built wth stone, & covered wth slate. It contains three cellars, the floors are earth. The passage, Hall, Kitchen, & dairy are laid wth stone... The glebe (w^{ch} consists of three tenements, & a parcel of ground called Sevenstones) is in the whole about eighty four acres... all inclosed wth hedges, for the most part belonging to it... The Home tenement contains, The courtage, gardens & houses about one acre, & $\frac{1}{4}$. three little meadows six acres & seventy six perch. nine inclosures of arable land, w^{ch} are contiguous & are bounded on the East by the highway; on the South & part of the West by the lands of m^r. Kirkham; other part by the Barton of Ockenbury.. on the North by lands of m^r. Shepherd; To the same tenement belong the Church meadow $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre; bounded on the West & South by the highway. on the East by lands of m^r. Kirkham; As also Heals, two acres & $\frac{3}{4}$ bounded on the South by the highway. on the East by lands of Dotten; on the North by lands of m^r. Shepherd. on the West by lands of m^r. Kirkham... Marwell tenement contains a Barn & straw house, a garden & field behind it, the whole about three acres; it fences itself. a meadow about one acre; a wet plot adjoining about twenty six perch. a plot wthin it (now an orchard) of about sixty perch, bounded on the North East by the lands of m^r. Kirkham. on the South, of m^r. Shepherd. wthin there is a small plot belonging to a tenement at Marwell (now in the possession of Peter Lambell). The occupier of w^{ch} tenement has a way thro' these two plots, part of the glebe, to his said plot; and the Rector of Rinmore, & his Tenants have a way thro' the said tenement to Marwell village.
