

## All Hallows Church


All Hallows Church was built in its present form around 1240, the tower being added the following century. A major restoration was carried out by the Rev'd Francis Hingston-Randolf in the latter part of the 19<sup>th</sup> century when the painting over the chancel arch was discovered. In the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century the nave walls were lined with decorative tin plate, this caused condensation and was replaced in 1961, by the present render.

Whilst the building is maintained in working condition, the ravages of time and weather constantly require further investment. In 2003 a millenium clock was added to the tower and more recently a church electronic hymnal has been purchased to provide music when there is no organist available. However the church organ is kept in working condition and is played regularly.

Through your generosity and support of this Flower Festival, we can continue to have a living Church as a focal point for the community in this beautiful rural village.
