Dear Mr Parkin,

Thank you for your enquiry regarding the Journey's End Inn, Ringmore.

I have checked the Electoral Registers for Ringmore for the 1930's and listed below are the entries relating to the inn.

### Electoral Registers – Ringmore

- 1932 David and Mary Nathoo of New Inn
- 1933 David and Mary Nathoo of New Inn  
Aubrey James Ryder of Journey's End
- 1934 Robert and Mary Pix of Journey's End Inn  
Fred Prowse of New Inn

It is not clear from the Electoral Registers, when the inn changed its name, as there are entries for the New Inn and the Journey's End Inn for 1933 and 1934. I also checked the Register of Licences for public houses, but found nothing relating to the New Inn, or the Journey's End Inn amongst the records, for this period.

The Kelly's Directory, 1935, lists that the Journey's End Inn, dates from 1300 AD. It is the only public house, in the parish, and is licensed by R W Pix. Unfortunately there is nothing listed for this public house in our subject index either.

- note
- (1) 1m Roof looks same on each - see angled down pipe
  - (2) Chimneys modified one of them twisted
  - (3) No window in front door on earliest
  - (4) Vertical tilty window has survived to this day
  - (5) Cottage re-roofed between oldest and 1959 photo.
  - (6) 1959 photo has sign of "pawm stop"!
  - (7) Oldest photo - you can see break in line of wall on left of front door but no sign of doorway into Nelsons bar
