

- * **SPEEDING TRAFFIC** The recommendations of the Highways Department Officer to repaint road markings, add a pedestrian sign to the 'road narrows' sign near the rectory, provide an additional 'slow' sign at the top of the hill leading into the village and add a chevron sign near the church wall were all approved.
- * Pedestrians should note that when walking through the village, it is best to keep to the outside of a bend, especially near Cross Manor corner, to avoid oncoming traffic.
- * The planning application for Challaborough Cottage had finally been approved; also the extension of Christies Licence at Challaborough.
