## Ryder family history

Hello Barry

My name is Steve Tomlinson, I live in Plymouth. My wife Lesley is a Ryder and we are trying to find as much information about the Ryder family that we can.

Would you be able to help us please?

We know that Lesley's Great Grandfather was William James Ryder born in South Brent Sept 1883, died in Plymouth in 1908. His father was James, born in South Brent in 1859, not sure of date of death, (married Elizabeth Ann Shillabeer 1883).

His father, Lesley's 3rd Great Grandfather, was also called James born in South Brent in 1830, he married Mary Ann Turner in June 1855.

The last Ryder that I have found is Lesley's 4th Great Grandfather Edward (1805 to 16-4-1887). Edward was born in Ringmore. His 1st marriage was to Maria also born in Ringmore in 1805, Maria died 2-8-1843. Maria and Edward are buried together in All Hollows graveyard. They had 4 children in Ringmore, James, Matilda born in 1843, George born in 1839 and Mary born in 1841. When Maria died, Edward married again to Mary Rendle in 1844. Mary was also born in Ringmore in 1806, Edward and Mary had 1 child - Elizabeth born in Ringmore in 1846.

That is where my records of our descendants stop. I can see from the 1841 Census that there are 14 separate Ryder families in Ringmore. I also note that there are several Ryder's buried in the Graveyard - the oldest appears to John who was born in 1726.

Do you know who Edward's father was? Do you have any additional information that can help us please? I understand that you have comprehensive burial records, and a manor rent list detailing cottages rented out by the Manor. Could we get a copy of these please?

Any information that you have would be really appreciated. We will be visiting Ringmore again, we would like to meet you if you can help. Thanks again. Regards Steve Tomlinson and Lesley Tomlinson (nee Ryder)
